UTILITY WORKER FATALITY

Northglenn, CO—At 10:19 a.m. this morning, North Metro Fire Rescue was dispatched to the northwest corner of Sheridan Boulevard and 120th Avenue in Broomfield on a accident involving two employees from Sturgeon Electric Company, Inc. Two adult male workers were putting up a line, which was not live, when something caused the bucket on their truck to give way.

One man was thrown from the bucket and struck the truck. He died from non-survivable injuries at the scene. North Metro paramedics transported the second worker to St. Anthony's Central for treatment of traumatic injuries.

OSHA was notified of this incident and the county coroner was also notified and responding to the scene.
