### **9 HEALTH FAIR - CANCELLED**

**Broomfield, CO**—Due to hazardous weather conditions, the 9 Health Fair scheduled for Saturday, April 18 at the Broomfield United Methodist Church has been cancelled. “We apologize for any inconvenience this causes for citizens intending to participate at this event,” states Wendy Forbes, North Metro Public Information Officer. “However, we do not want to encourage people to travel out in this storm and risk any form of an injury.”

Due to scheduling conflicts, North Metro will be unable to move the date for this event. However, citizens are encouraged to attend an alternative Broomfield 9 Health Fair location at the Nativity of Our Lord Catholic Church, 900 W. Midway Boulevard, Broomfield. This 9 Health Fair will be held on Saturday, April 25 from 7 a.m. until noon.

While no guarantees can be made at this time, North Metro is working to move some of the screenings originally scheduled exclusively for the Broomfield United Methodist Church site to the April 25 event. “Our hope is to provide the majority of screenings that were originally expected to be split between two venues,” explained Forbes.
