North Metro Launches T-shirt Drive to benefit Susan G.Komen**

Northglenn/Broomfield, CO— Beginning September 1 until supplies run out, North Metro will offer specialty pink t-shirts to the public for a set donation price. Adult sizes will be offered for \$20 and youth for \$15. Proceeds raised through the t-shirts will benefit the Denver affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure. Shirts are available Monday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. at North Metro Fire Rescue District Headquarters located at 10550 Huron Street in Northglenn.
