APARTMENT FIRE—7015 W. 120th Avenue

Broomfield, CO—At approximately 10:30 a.m. on January 28, 2008 North Metro Fire Rescue responded to a confirmed apartment fire at 7015 W. 120th Avenue (Courtyard Apartments) in Broomfield. Upon arrival fire crews found smoke coming from a first story apartment and residents were evacuating. Fortunately no citizens or firefighters were injured during the fire and evacuation.

North Metro Firefighters worked on the blaze and found it located in the ceiling between the 1st and 2nd floor. Only one unit was damaged by fire and a 2nd unit experienced some smoke damage. The residents of only one unit will be displaced.

The last fire at this apartment complex was on August 14, 2006. The fire was located in a different building and was caused by a malfunctioning bathroom fan. Five units were destroyed in that blaze. Fire Investigators are currently investigating today's fire, but preliminary reports suggest the cause may have been by an electrical source.
