DROWNING AT BROOMFIELD ATHLETIC CLUB

Broomfield, CO—At approximately 10:50 a.m. on May 27, 2008 North Metro Fire Rescue responded to Lakeshore Athletic Club in Broomfield on a possible drowning. Upon arrival fire paramedics found two civilians, both with various levels of medical training, performing CPR on an adult male that had been pulled from an indoor lap pool.

North Metro paramedics resumed treatment and transported the man to Avista Hospital. Sadly, the man was unable to be revived. Witnesses at the athletic facility indicated that the man had been the only person swimming in the lap pool which was known to be an unattended (no lifeguard) swimming area.

At this time Broomfield Police Department is completing their formal ID process of the victim and is notifying next of kin.
