North Metro Fire Seeks Applicants for Citizens Academy

Applications due end of February

Northglenn/Broomfield, CO – North Metro Fire Rescue District is hosting its Citizens Academy starting March 26 and ending May 4. Those interested in participating in the academy should submit their applications by February 23.

Academy participants will learn the ins and outs of the fire district, including:

- An overview of North Metro Fire, how its
- Emergency communications, 911 dispatch
- Emergency response and types of calls
- Firefighter training and fire operations
- Special teams: wildland, technical rescue,
- Community risk reduction and outreach
- Fire prevention, risk reduction and fire

The six-week academy will include both classroom education and hands-on activities taught by North Metro firefighters and staff and designed to be fun and



The Citizens Academy is free for participants and open to fire district residents at least 18 years of age who submit an application and fulfill the minimum program requirements. The academy will be limited to 20 individuals and will be held primarily on Tuesday evenings from 6 to 9 p.m. at various North Metro Fire facilities. On the final Saturday, academy participants will spend the day at the district's Training Center in Northglenn learning how firefighters train for the job. Following the academy's completion, participants will be recognized at a graduation ceremony during the fire district's monthly board meeting.
