## **North Metro Fire Seeks Candidates for Board of Directors**

**Broomfield/Northglenn, CO** — North Metro Fire Rescue District is seeking candidates to run in its upcoming Board of Directors election on May 8, 2018. Two director positions are open, and those who are elected will serve four-year terms.

Those interested in serving on North Metro Fire's Board of Directors may obtain a self-nomination and acceptance form from the District's Headquarters or through its website ([www.nmfr.org/boardelection](http://www.nmfr.org/boardelection)). The nomination form must be completed and returned to the District's Administration Building located at 101 Spader Way, Broomfield, Colorado 80020 no later than close of business on Friday, March 2, 2018.

All Directors must meet the following requirements:

- Must be a resident of the District for at least 30 days; or
- The owner (or spouse of the owner) of taxable real or personal property situated within boundaries of the District (must provide spouse's name if property is in spouse's name); or
- A person who is obligated to pay taxes under a contract to purchase taxable property within the District.

The Board of Directors has five members. The Board establishes policies and sets the annual budgets for the District. The fire chief is the chief executive officer of the District. The fire chief reports to the Board. The fire chief and his staff manage all of the day-to-day operations of the District in accordance with the policies and budget established by the Board. The Board usually meets the third Tuesday of every month at 5:00 p.m. The Board also has additional meetings when there is a need to do so.
