North Metro Fire Announces Results from Board of Director Election

Northglenn/Broomfield, CO – North Metro Fire Rescue District election polls closed at 7 p.m. on May 3, 2016. From the votes tallied, the unofficial results show that District residents have re-elected John Abboud, Tim Long and Jenni Murphy to serve another four years on the North Metro Fire Board of Directors. The election results were as follows:

The results will be officially confirmed on May 11 once the eight-day window closes for absentee ballots to be received from uniformed and overseas citizens.

For John Abboud, it will be his second term serving on North Metro Fire's board. He has served as the board president for the past two years and has been a resident of Broomfield since 2002. Prior to being elected to the fire district board, Abboud spent more than 30 years in the petroleum industry, working his way up to serve as chief operating officer. He also is an active member of the Broomfield Rotary Club.

Jenni Murphy also returns to the board for another four-year term. She currently serves as the board's secretary. Murphy has been a long-time presence in Northglenn, having lived in the city for over 30 years and having worked for the city for nearly half that time. Alongside her board position, Murphy serves as the community outreach coordinator for the City of Northglenn.

Returning member, Tim Long, is the board's current treasurer and has also served on the board since 2012. Long has been a Northglenn resident since 1999 and has served as a Northglenn Urban Renewal Authority Commissioner and consulted on various healthcare development projects in the area.

“I want to thank all of the candidates who ran this year. We are fortunate to have residents interested in serving on our board and helping guide our fire district to be one of the best in the metro area,” said North Metro Fire Chief Dave Ramos.

The three elected candidates will be sworn in for their new terms at the North Metro Fire Rescue District board meeting on May 17, 2016, which begins at 5 p.m. This meeting will be held at the District’s Headquarters at 101 Spader Way in Broomfield. Other members of the District’s board include Robert Nielsen and Dennis Day, both of Broomfield.
