North Metro Fire Invites Community to Annual Flag Retirement Ceremony and Open House

Northglenn/Broomfield, CO—North Metro Fire Rescue District and the Broomfield Veterans Memorial Museum are joining together to host the 11th Annual Flag Retirement Ceremony on Saturday, June 13, in Broomfield. Following the ceremony, there will be an open house at the fire station and hot dog cookout.

The event will be held at North Metro Fire Station 61 at 1275 Midway Boulevard beginning at 11 a.m. A joint honor guard from North Metro Fire and Broomfield Police Department will be a part of the ceremony as well as North Metro Fire Chief David Ramos and representatives from the Broomfield Veterans Memorial Museum. A local bugler will also perform as part of the service.

“We’re grateful for this opportunity to partner with the Veterans Memorial Museum and honor our flag and its heritage,” said Ramos. “We invite all of our community members to come and join us in this patriotic ceremony. It’s especially a great opportunity for younger residents to learn how to respectfully retire our nation’s flag.”

District residents may take part in the ceremony by helping with the proper retirement of flags that have been collected throughout the community. After the flags have been retired, the District will host an open house, where residents can tour the fire station and enjoy a red, white and blue themed cookout to celebrate Flag Day, which follows on Sunday.
