# REGISTER A COOK-OFF TEAM

The Red and Blue BBQ Cook-Off started with one firefighter's personal journey with cancer and his desire to give back and raise money to support other Colorado first responders and their families facing difficult times.

The 2nd Annual Red and Blue BBQ Cook-Off includes a friendly competition of pitmasters, a head-to-head pig roast battle between North Metro Fire Rescue District and the Northglenn Police Department, a day of live music and fun festivities, and support for local charities. Tickets will be available to purchase to sample BBQ from the cook-off teams, and all profits from the event will go directly to charity.

## *Top 10 Reasons to Enter the Red and Blue BBQ Cook-Off*

1. You will be helping two worthy charities—the Colorado Professional Firefighters Foundation and Colorado C.O.P.S.
2. You have a chance to steal the title of BBQ grand champion from last year's winner.
3. If you win, you'll be taking home a grand prize that will make your friends jealous.
4. You may pick up some ideas to perfect your sauce and rub recipes.
5. You could win bragging rights for your department or business for the rest of the year.
6. There will be a beverage tent to quench your thirst.
7. The Emerald Society Pipes and Drums band comprised of local firefighters and police officers will give a special performance.
8. You can bring your entire family to enjoy a fun-filled day, including activities for the kids.
9. You can rock out to live bands performing your old-school favorites.
10. It's a Saturday filled with BBQing, listening to live music and hanging out with old and new friends while supporting first responders—what more could you want?

## *Requirements and Logistics*

- Each team may enter three categories (Chicken, Brisket, Pork Ribs) for \$20/category, or a team may enter all three categories for \$50. Teams can register and pay online for their entry or fill out the entry form on the following page and make a check payable to North Metro Fire Rescue Community Foundation. Send both the entry form and check to North Metro Fire, Attn: Lisa Willis, 101 Spader Way, Broomfield, CO 80020.
- In addition to the entry fee, each team is expected to provide 100 samples of their meat of choice to serve to the public. Samples should be a minimum of two ounces. For each sample ticket a team turns in following the event, they will be reimbursed \$0.50/ticket.
- Award categories include: chicken, brisket, pork ribs and grand champion. A winner and runner up will be awarded for each individual category.
- In order to compete for the grand champion prize, you must enter all meat categories.
- Each team captain will receive competition guidelines and will be responsible for following the food and safety measures set forth in the guidelines.
- Teams will have a designated 12x24 parking lot space for cooking. Teams can begin setting up their cook-off space at 5 p.m. on May 31. Teams will also have a booth/table space at E.B. Rains Jr. Memorial Park to distribute samples to the public.
- A competitors meeting will be held at 8 p.m. on May 31.
- Each team is responsible for bringing all of their supplies for the cook-off and for staffing a separate food booth to distribute samples. No electricity will be provided for competitors.
- Judging of entries will begin at 12 p.m.
- Award winners will be announced approximately at 4:30 p.m.
